We have received 18 anonymous responses for the Hospitality Survey. Since this topic is still open for discussion in the Visitor Economy meetings, we encourage more input. The more feedback we receive, the better we can tailor potential opportunities to meet the desired needs.

NATURE TOURISM

Last month we had another great working group discussion, with future opportunities following. Highlight was hearing from **Tim Gentle from Think.Digital**. Tim gave an overview on the different ways to use AR, he shared his knowledge of 10 years working in the industry

Tim showed a gamified, map based app called Goosechase (non-AR) that would be a good starting point for the AR experience. Tim has used this app with his children to get them exploring an area and doing activities, all while tracking where they are via his phone. It was also discussed about using AR to point at a location and it presents a story or image going back in time and providing opportunity for education schools.

Another instance is the Sheep EAD AR app and Farm AR app, which can be downloaded on phones. Try it out to explore its functionality and gain insight into how AR can be integrated into the Visitor Economy of Nowa Nowa.


